The Association of Professional Engineers, Geologists and Geophysicists of Alberta (APEGGA) has been a vibrant and progressive professional association fulfilling the mandate given to it by the Engineering, Geological and Geophysical Professions Act since 1920.

APEGGA registers, sets practice standards and determines disciplinary actions, when necessary, for its more than 40,000 members. APEGGA is a self-governing association responsible to the people of Alberta for the licensing of professional engineers, geologists and geophysicists, under the Engineering, Geological and Geophysical Professions (EGGP) Act, an Alberta Government statute. This means that only those individuals licensed with APEGGA can practice or use titles relating to these three professions on projects in Alberta.

There are nine branches along with one district, a head office in Edmonton and an administrative office in Calgary all working to serve the members of APEGGA. Members also receive copies of the publication The Pegg, along with access to other professional publications. It promotes professional development through a number of initiatives including workshops, meetings and its online employment center.

APEGGA promotes education through various outreach programs like classroom presentations, awards for teachers, hosting science fairs and more. Its Education Foundation also gives scholarships to support those entering the profession.
