Local Engineering Student Wins Prestigious National Scholarship

Tiffany Edgecombe of Edmonton, Alberta has been named the top engineering Ph.D student across Canada by the Canadian Engineering Memorial Foundation. Ms. Edgecombe will receive the \$15,000 Claudette MacKay-Lassonde Graduate Engineering Scholarship in recognition of her accomplishment.

Currently a full-time doctoral student at the University of Calgary, Ms. Edgecombe is researching the areas of biomechanics and sports engineering.

“Tiffany is a remarkable person – among her numerous achievements she volunteers as a mentor to other engineering students through the SCIberMENTOR program, is a member of the Alberta Water Ski Team and has competed and coached in the sport, along with being an avid runner, biker and downhill skier.

The Canadian Engineering Memorial Foundation is proud to present her with this well-deserved scholarship, and we have every confidence that she will continue to succeed in her future endeavours,” says Suzelle Barrington, CEMF President. “There is no doubt that Tiffany is a future leader in engineering.”

The Canadian Engineering Memorial Foundation was founded in 1990 to develop scholarship and award programs that encourage women to choose engineering as a career to honour the memory of the 14 women at École Polytechnique whose contributions to Canada ended on December 6, 1989.

Along with Ms. Edgecombe, CEMF provides five undergraduate scholarships and has partnered with CVRD Inco Limited, AMEC, IBM Canada and Hewlett-Packard to provide engineering scholarships at the undergraduate and Master levels.
